

Volunteer Role Descriptions



Small Group Leader

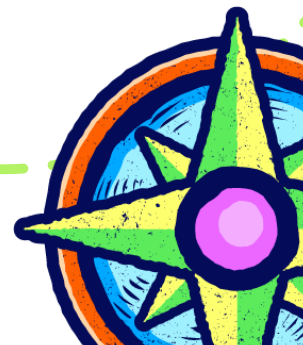
This position is the primary leader for a group of up to 10 kids; stays with the same group all week; encourages spiritual growth, relationships, discussion, and other Small Group activities. Small Group Leaders will remain the primary leader for their group as they engage in different indoor and outdoor activities and during Large Group. The Small Group Leader will be responsible for leading discussion/activities during Small Group time each day.

- Camp Week Time Commitment
 - Monday 8am - 5pm
 - Tuesday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Wednesday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Thursday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Friday 8:30am - 2pm
- Position Requirements
 - Must be 16 years of age or older.
 - Willing to complete a background check (18+ only), if one is not already on file with River Oaks.
 - Attend Kids Camp Volunteer Training
- Lunch is provided for these volunteers each day of camp.
- For these volunteers, Preschool Camp is available for children age 2 through 5 years old at no cost. Space is limited and available first to children of Small Group Leader volunteers.

Activity Station Volunteer

This position will assist in preparation and facilitation of different indoor and outdoor activity stations. These stations include various inflatables, water activities, field games, tie-dye and more.

- Activity stations operate from 11am to 3pm Monday through Thursday.
 - The time commitment for this role will depend on which activity station you express interest in. A member of our planning team will reach out to you to assign roles and define the time commitments once sign ups are completed.
- Position Requirements
 - Must be 16 years of age or older.
 - Willing to complete a background check (18+ only), if one is not already on file with River Oaks.
 - Attend Kids Camp Volunteer Training
- Lunch is provided for these volunteers each day of camp.
- For these volunteers who serve more than 4 hours per day, Preschool Camp is available for children 2 through 5 years old at no cost. Space is limited and available first to children of Small Group Leader volunteers.



Daily Support Volunteer

This position will assist in equipping small group leaders through activity supply preparation and classroom pick-up; assists in moving kids to and from activity rotations; assists with administrative tasks associated with day-to-day camp operation.

- The time commitment for this position is flexible, based on volunteer availability, however it is beneficial to the flow of camp operations to have consistent help throughout the week.
- Position Requirements
 - Must be 18 years of age or older.
 - Willing to complete a background check (18+ only), if one is not already on file with River Oaks.
 - Attend Kids Camp Volunteer Training
- Lunch is provided for these volunteers each day of camp.
- For these volunteers who serve more than 4 hours per day, Preschool Camp is available for children 2 through 5 years old at no cost. Space is limited and available first to children of Small Group Leader volunteers.

Registration Volunteer

This position will assist in facilitating the registration process for all campers; collecting camper information; and providing camper group assignments to families.

- Time Commitment
 - 2 hour commitment during one or more registration sessions leading up to camp, and on the Monday morning of camp.
 - Registration sessions are tentatively scheduled for Thursday (06/16) and Friday (06/17) from 3pm to 5pm, Sunday (06/18) morning during all services, Monday (06/19) morning 8:30am-9:30am.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.

Set Up & Tear Down Volunteer

This position will assist in setup and teardown of the the church building and grounds in preparation for camp and resetting spaces after camp is complete on the final day.

- Time Commitment
 - Set Up - Sunday, June 18th from 3pm to 5pm
 - Tear Down - Friday, June 23rd from 3pm to 5pm

Student Small Group Leader

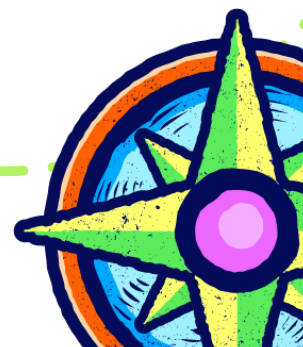
This position will partner with an adult leader as the primary teachers for a group of up to 10 kids; stays with the same group all week; encourages spiritual growth, relationships, discussion, and other Small Group activities. Student Small Group Leaders will assist in leading their group of kids as they engage in different indoor and outdoor activities and during Large Group.

- Camp Week Time Commitment
 - Monday 8am - 5pm
 - Tuesday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Wednesday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Thursday 8:30am - 5pm
 - Friday 8:30am - 2pm
- Position Requirements
 - Must be 16 years of age or older by the start of camp.
 - Needs to exhibit a level of maturity capable of leading younger students and completing assigned tasks with little redirection.
 - Attend Kids Camp Volunteer Training
- Lunch is provided for these volunteers each day of camp.

Activity Station Volunteer

- Position Requirements
 - Must have completed 6th grade by the end of the 22/23 school year.
 - Needs to exhibit a level of maturity capable of leading younger students and completing assigned tasks with little redirection.
 - Attend Kids Camp Volunteer Training
- Lunch is provided for these volunteers each day of camp.

Other Information

Student leaders who plan to attend River Oaks Student Camp can apply for a scholarship to assist in lowering the cost of Student Camp registration.
